Quantum and Delay Analysis Claims

- I was instructed by a contractor to provide a claim for extension of time and delay costs as loss & expense. I carried out a retrospective delay analysis based on the As-Planned vs As-Built method, and I quantified £600,000 of prolongation costs as loss & expense pursuant to the applicable contractual provisions. I provided the claim as a standalone document in report format and submitted the claim document to the contractor's client. My claim assisted the contractor in avoiding a formal dispute by achieving a settlement by agreement.
- I was instructed by a contractor to respond to its clients' contentions that the contractor was responsible for delay. I managed the procurement of the evidence and drafted a delay notice and a loss & expense notice in accordance with the contractual provisions. I carried out a delay analysis and quantified a claim for £550,000 as loss & expense to include prolonged preliminary costs, preliminary thickening costs, and disrupted labour costs as a loss of productivity. My claim assisted the contractor in reaching a settlement of the matter with its client.
